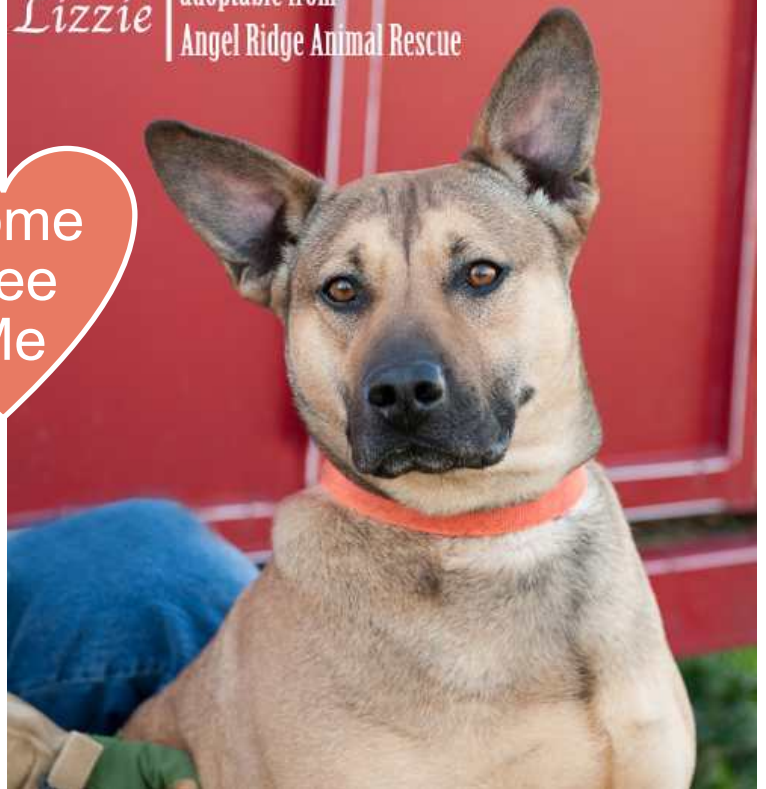


Loving Lizzie
